for a Performance by Arahmaiani

Get the chance to work together with one of the most influential performance artists from Indonesia at Hamburger Bahnhof – Museum für Gegenwart – Berlin. The artist Arahmaiani is seeking for 30 participants for her ongoing performance "Flag Project", which will take place as part of the conference and performance program "Embodied Histories – Entangled Communities. Southeast Asian and Western Approaches to Narratives and Performance Art".

Flag Project

Performance, 2019

During the performance, the participants will be asked to carry the flags and to follow the instructions by Arahmaiani. There will be a rehearsal day before the performance, during which the artist wants to get to know the participants and discuss, together with them, what their idea of a community is and to form the exact outcome of the performance. The different flags, which have been produced in a special region of Yogyakarta by a group of seamstresses, each show a "key word", taken from dialogues and discussions between Arahmaiani and different communities around the world. The project's main goal is to collectively explore values within a community. By discussing this in a group and by agreeing on shared values, the participants, together with the artist will create a temporal community.
